

THE FIRE COMMISSIONERS.

General Transfer Made by the Department.

The Board of Fire Commissioners met yesterday afternoon.

On the recommendation of Chief Scannell a new fire-box was located at the corner of Bay and Webster streets. At the recent fire in the meat-packing establishment of Roth, Blum & Co., in that locality, much valuable time was lost in turning in the alarm from the nearest box.

W. H. Brown, heretofore stoker of Engine Company 2, was transferred to Engine Company 8 and made driver of the same. John Allen, driver of Engine Company 8, was placed on the roll of Engine Company 15, in the same capacity. John Haines, driver of Engine Company 15, was appointed to Hose Company 8, where he will also hold the reins. G. Clancey, who has been driver of Engine Company 8, was transferred to the position of stokerman of Engine Company 2, made vacant by the transfer of W. H. Brown.

LIGHT SENTENCES.

Criminals Let Off Easy by Judge Murphy.

Sentence day was observed yesterday in Judge Murphy's department of the criminal court. Tarm Seung, a Chinese who has been here since 1868, most of the time since his arrival having been spent in the penitentiary, was released on his own recognizance, with the understanding that he was to return to China by the next steamer. Consul Bee assured the court that Seung would never come back to America.

Louis Sanguinetti, formerly proprietor of the Montana Saloon, a Kearny-street dive, was denied a new trial and sentenced to four years' imprisonment in San Quentin for embezzling \$70 from L. A. Johns about three months ago.

GUSTAVE REIS' WILL.

His Son Gets the Entire Valuable Property.

The will of Gustave Reis, filed yesterday, was made in March, 1856. By it his entire estate, valued at \$200,000, goes to his son, John O. Reis, with the recommendation that he look out for his grandmother, Mrs. O'Neill, and her daughters. It is understood that Reis' estate was much larger than this, but he reduced it to this figure by conveying real estate to his son by deed before death.
